### **Gift Barrel Carrier:**

**VOLUNTEER DUTIES:** Represent Gifts For Seniors by picking up gift barrels at storage site a week before Thanksgiving and delivering them to host sites in the metro area. Returns gift barrels to storage site the week after New Year's Day. Acts as an ambassador for the program when interacting with host site staff.

**Time Commitment** - A few hours or a full day prior to Thanksgiving and another block of hours the first week in January. Flexibility of schedule of pickup/delivery times – weekdays, evenings, weekends.

### **Gifts Collector:**

**VOLUNTEER DUTIES:** Represent Gifts For Seniors in picking up donated gifts in the community at one or more Host Sites and delivering the gifts to a secure program facility. Acts as an ambassador for the program when interacting with host site staff.

**A minimum commitment** of 3 weeks @ several hours on 2 to 3 days each week. Flexibility of schedule for pickup times – weekdays, evenings, weekends - during December 2007 through first week of January 2008.
